- 1. We will earnestly seek God's power to grow us in the unity of the body and the bond of peace. (John 17:17-21; Eph 3:20-21; Eph 4:1-3)
- 2. We will be devoted to the Church Gathering, and to praying for ourselves and others. (Acts 13:1-3; Acts 2:42-27; 4:31; 20:7; Heb 10:25)
- 3. We will work together to continue the faithful Gospel ministry of this church.
  - · To sustain it's worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines;
  - To contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of it's ministries, the expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the Gospel both locally and globally.

- 4. We will strive to love one another.
  - · By exercising an affectionate care and watchfulness over each other;
  - · By faithfully encouraging and admonishing one another, as occasion may require;
  - · By walking in humility, being mindful of our words, and being slow to take offense;
  - By always being ready to reconcile with each other. (Rom 12:10, 16:17-18; Gal 6:1-2; Matt 18:15-17; Jas 5:19-20; Col 3:16; Heb 3:12-13; 1 Thess 5:11; 1 Cor 5:12)
- 5. We will rejoice at each other's happiness and bear each other's burdens and sorrows with tenderness and sympathy.

- 6. We will endeavor to use the gifts of the Holy Spirit in the home and in the church.
  - · To maintain personal, and when possible, family devotions;
  - To intentionally educate and lead our children in the Christian faith;
  - · To share the Gospel with others and seek the salvation of those who have yet to receive Christ;
  - To be equipped by the Word of God to be disciples who make disciples. (Deut 6:1-12; 11:18-20; Matt 6:6; Eph 6:4; Mk 5:19; Lk 5:19; Matt 5:16; Eph 5:15; Matt 28:18)
- 7. We will submit to the authority of Scripture in all areas of life.
  - To live wisely in the world, denying ungodliness, gossip, and worldly desires;
  - To remind ourselves that as new creations in Christ, we have a special obligation to lead new and holy lives.

- 8. We will, if we move from this church family.
  - · Inform and meet with an elder prior to our departure;
  - As soon as possible, unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.
